Donation of golf carts helps improve campus efficiency and safety for teachers, staff and students.

WINDSOR, CA – Windsor High School has had golf carts to aid in navigating the large campus over the years. The golf carts help staff get across campus quickly to deal with medical emergencies and/or safety issues. They are utilized to aid students who may be ill or physically challenged, and are used by staff to move supplies. For administrators or staff who have medical challenges, the golf carts have become a crucial link aiding in efficient navigation across campus. They further aid staff in having an improved ability to provide increased supervision and support to programs and classroom instruction.

Over the years, Windsor High School has benefitted from numerous community donations of these golf carts including several from the Windsor Golf Course. After retiring two that could no longer be repaired, Superintendent Tammy Gabel reached out to the community again to seek new golf carts to provide the assistance to the administrators and staff at Windsor High School.

The Lytton Rancheria of California swiftly answered her request by donating two new champagne beige E-Z-GO Model TXT golf carts, with sun canopies. These carts will replace the recently retired vehicles and provide the much-needed assistance to teachers, faculty and administrators at the school.

According to chairperson Margie Mejia of The Lytton Rancheria of California, "We are so proud to provide this support of Windsor High School and hope that our donation will assist teachers and staff in their commitment to educate our youth!" Superintendent Gabel concurred stating, "The safety of our students and staff is an on-going priority and these golf carts will go a long ways to ensuring staff are able to navigate the campus quickly and effectively." She continued by saying, "We are thrilled to receive the contribution from The Lytton Rancheria of California and look forward to additional partnerships in the future!"

Marc Elin, Principal of Windsor High School stated, "Serving 1750 students on an open 38 acre campus requires the ability to move quickly from one point whether general supervision or transporting students for health related reasons. Currently the campus has only one used golf cart to meet all these needs. The two additional new golf carts will provide the administration and student advisors with multiple transportation options to meet the growing needs of Windsor High."

The new golf carts will be presented by Chairperson Margie Mejia to the Windsor Unified School District, Board of Trustees, Vice-President Billy Forest in a brief ceremony Windsor Unified School District Windsor High School on April 24, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. under the entryway arch. The brief ceremony will conclude with a brief tour of the campus using the new golf carts!
