Board of Trustees Accepts Resignation from Superintendent Tammy Gabel, effective November 30, 2013

November 20, 2013—The Windsor Unified School District Board of Trustees voted to accept the resignation by Dr. Tammy Gabel, Superintendent of Windsor Unified School District, effective November 30, 2013.

Superintendent Gabel, hired by the Windsor Board of Trustees, in July of 2011, has served the Windsor Unified School District for the past two and a half years. In a press release distributed on Wednesday, November 20, she stated: “Due to the needs of my family needing my immediate attention, I will need to leave the District much earlier than I had intended.”

While Dr. Gabel’s immediate plans are to focus on the needs of her family, she doesn’t rule out continuing work in the area of public education at some point in the future.

Dr. Gabel commented, “Working in the Community of Windsor has been a true honor. The Windsor community is very unique and the support of the community for its schools and other community events is very special.”

Billy Forrest, President of the Windsor Board of Trustees stated, “An interim Superintendent will be brought in to the District while the District prepares to go through a comprehensive search process in the near future.”
