ITEM: **CONSIDERATION OF APPROVAL OF GUIDEPOST SOLUTIONS PROPOSAL TO DESIGN WINDSOR HIGH SCHOOL VIDEO SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM**

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

During the development of the Facilities Utilization Master Plan (FUMP) the Board of Trustees developed a Facilities Project List for Measure F bond funds. Included on the list for Phase funding is \$2,000,000 for school safety. This allocation is meant for any measure meant to increase safety and security on our campuses including but not limited to security cameras, Columbine locks and fencing. On December 19, 2017 the Board of Trustees accepted Guidepost Solutions proposal for a district wide security assessment and on March 6, 2018 the Board reviewed their report.

CURRENT CONSIDERATION:

Guidepost Solutions has put together a proposal for the Windsor High School Video Surveillance System which includes the design of a new low voltage IP-based network video surveillance system. The primary components will include network video recorders, and IP-based video cameras. Scope of services will include schematic design, design development, construction documents, bidding process and evaluation of contractor's proposals.

RECOMMENDATION:

District Administration respectfully requests that the Board approve the proposal from Guidepost Solutions for the Windsor High School Surveillance System.
