ITEM: PROPOSED CHANGES TO BOARD POLICY 6146.1- HIGH

SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR WINDSOR OAKS ACADEMY AND NORTH BAY MET ACADEMY

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

With the addition of North Bay Met Academy, graduation requirements regarding electives are being proposed for North Bay Met Academy and Windsor Oaks Academy.

Windsor Oaks Academy will operate as a continuation high school, and currently requires 200 credits for graduation, which is 20 fewer elective requirements than Windsor High School.

The new proposal includes 180 credits for graduation, with 40 fewer elective credits than Windsor High School. Windsor Oaks Academy students will not complete senior projects.

North Bay Met Academy will operate as an alternative school. It is proposed that the school require 200 credits for graduation, which is 20 fewer elective credit requirements than Windsor High School. North Bay Met students will complete quarterly exhibitions instead of a senior project.

The attached proposed Board Policy includes detailed information regarding the proposal.
